

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Don Pedro, Malasiqui, Pangasinan

as of 24 April 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 06 April 2025 at around 1:00 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Don Pedro, Malasiqui, Pangasinan. Due to the incident, eight (8) individuals were affected, significantly damaging their house.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) I, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Malasiqui, Pangasinan, provided relief assistance to address the urgent needs of the affected individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of four (4) families or eight (8) persons are affected in Brgy. Don Pedro, Malasiqui, Pangasinan (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or five (5) persons are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Don Pedro, Malasiqui, Pangasinan (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱14,970.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱10,000.00 from DSWD and ₱4,970.00 from the LGU (see Annex D).

1. Standby Funds
