

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Dontogan, Baguio City

as of 29 April 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 18 April 2025 at around 3:40 AM, a fire incident occurred at Foggy Hill Talco Compound, Brgy. Dontogan, Baguio City. The fire was declared out at around 4:20 AM. A residential structure was completely destroyed, and two (2) individuals were injured, requiring their hospitalization at the Baguio General Hospital and Medical Center (BGHMC) for medical treatment.
