

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Inayawan, Cebu City as of 06 April 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 05 April 2025 at around 2:18 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Inayawan, Cebu City. The fire was declared out at around 3:34 PM. Due to the incident, 207 individuals were affected, significantly damaging their houses.

At present, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) through its Field Office (FO) VII, is closely coordinating with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Cebu City, for updates and any request for relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected individuals.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **55 families** or **207 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Inayawan, Cebu City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **55 families** or **207 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Inayawan Gym** in **Brgy. Inayawan, Cebu City** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **41 houses** were damaged; of which, **36** are **totally damaged** and **five (5)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Inayawan, Cebu City** (see Annex C).
