

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Liwayway, Macarthur, Leyte

as of 28 April 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 12 April 2025 at around 7:30 PM, a fire incident occurred at Zone 1, Brgy. Liwayway, Macarthur, Leyte. The fire was declared out at around 10:00 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or six (6) persons are affected in Brgy. Liwayway, Macarthur, Leyte (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or six (6) persons are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Liwayway, Macarthur, Leyte (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P8,839.15** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected family (see Annex D).
