

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Liwayway, Macarthur, Leyte as of 28 April 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 12 April 2025 at around 7:30 PM, a fire incident occurred at Zone 1, Brgy. Liwayway, Macarthur, Leyte. The fire was declared out at around 10:00 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or **six (6) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Liwayway, Macarthur, Leyte** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **six (6) persons** are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Liwayway, Macarthur, Leyte** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱8,839.15** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected family (see Annex D).
