I. Situation Overview

On 17 April 2025 at around 3:30 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 5, Brgy. North Poblacion, Medina, Misamis Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 3:55 PM.

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. North Poblacion, Medina, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex C).

A total of **₱5,000.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** to the affected family (see Annex D).
