I. Situation Overview

On 12 April 2025 at around 11:21 PM, a fire incident occurred at Makabayan St., Brgy. Obrero, Quezon City. The fire was put under control at 2:52 AM.

A total of **177 families** or **622 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Obrero, Quezon City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **177 families** or **622 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Don Alejandro Roces Senior Science and Technology High School** in **Brgy. Obrero, Quezon City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **38 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Obrero, Quezon City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱243,906.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
