

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion III, Hamtic, Antique

25 April 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 26 January 2025 at around 5:39 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Poblacion III, Hamtic, Antique. The fire was declared out at around 6:11 AM.

A total of **six (6) families** or **16 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Poblacion III, Hamtic, Antique** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **six (6) families** or **16 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Barangay Hall** in **Brgy. Poblacion III, Hamtic, Antique** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **six (6) houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Poblacion III, Hamtic, Antique** (see Annex D).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱37,716.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex E).
