

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion, Libmanan, Camarines Sur

as of 22 April 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 21 April 2025, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Surrender, Brgy. Poblacion, Libmanan, Camarines Sur. Due to the incident, 143 individuals were affected resulting in significant damages in their houses.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) through its Field Office (FO) V, in close coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Libmanan, Camarines Sur, immediately provided relief assistance to address the urgent needs of the affected individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **28 families** or **143 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Poblacion**, **Libmanan**, **Camarines Sur** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **28 families** or **143 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at **Libmanan Cultural Center** in **Brgy. Sagrada, Libmanan, Camarines Sur** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 14 houses were damaged; of which 12 are totally damaged and two (2) are partially damaged in Brgy. Poblacion, Libmanan, Camarines Sur (see Annex D).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P235,138.12** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex E).
