

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Taculing, Bacolod City as of 03 April 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 31 March 2025 at around 4:51 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Taculing, Bacolod City.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **four (4) families** or **16 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Taculing, Bacolod City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **four (4) families** or **16 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Multi Purpose Hall** in **Brgy. Taculing, Bacolod City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **four (4) houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Taculing, Bacolod City** (see Annex D).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱43,160.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱26,000.00** from **DSWD** and **₱17,160.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex E).
