I. Situation Overview

On 06 April 2025 at around 4:00 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Tiblong, San Fabian, Pangasinan.

One (1) family or four (4) persons are affected in Brgy. Tiblong, San Fabian, Pangasinan (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or four (4) persons are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Tiblong, San Fabian, Pangasinan (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P11,018.36** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected family (see Annex D).
