

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flash Flood Incidents in Glan, Sarangani

as of 01 April 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 31 March 2025 at 4:00 AM, the weather report indicated partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms, attributed to the prevailing Easterlies. These conditions heightened the risk of flash floods or landslides, particularly during severe thunderstorms, across Metro Manila and the entire country.

On the same day, several barangays in Glan, Sarangani, experienced flash floods due to heavy rainfall brought by the Easterlies.

Relative to the incident, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office in Region XII, actively engaged in the response operation and closely coordinating with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Glan for timely updates and to address any potential requests for relief augmentation.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **2,792 families** or **13,960 persons** are affected in **eight (8) barangays** in **Glan, Sarangani** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

There are **404 families** or **2,020 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Municipal Gymnasium** in **Glan, Sarangani** (see Annex B).
