

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Armed Conflict in Cabanglasan, Bukidnon

as of 04 April 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 March 2025, an armed conflict transpired between the government troops of the 4th Infantry Division and members of the New People's Army in the mountains in Cabanglasan, Bukidnon.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **154 families** or **770 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Cabanglasan, Bukidnon** (see Annex A).

III. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱245,788.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of **₱95,788.00** from **DSWD** and **₱150,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex B).
