

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Armed Conflict in Kabugao, Apayao as of 16 May 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 05 April to 11 April 2025, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. Maragat and Brgy. Dagara in Kabugao, Apayao between the Philippine Army's 98th Infantry (MASINAG) Battalion and the members of the Communist Terrorists Group (CTG) resulting in the displacement of families and individuals in the area.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **335 families** or **1,330 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Kabugao, Apayao** (see Annex A).

### III. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱531,209.50** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex B).
