

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 118, Tondo, Manila City as of 29 April 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 23 April 2025 at around 1:57 AM, a fire incident occurred at Rawis St., Brgy. 118, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared under control at 7:09 AM. No casualties were reported during the incident.

There are **130 families** or **420 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Barangay 118 Covered Court** in **Brgy. 118, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex B).

A total of **50 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 118, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex C).
