

# DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 123, Tondo, Manila City

as of 25 April 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 23 April 2025 at around 1:56 AM, a fire incident occurred at Road 10, Moriones St., Brgy 123, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 7:09 AM. Due to the incident, 2,370 individuals were affected, resulting in significant damages to their houses.

As part of the response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) National Capital Region (NCR), immediately conducted Rapid Disaster Assessment and Needs Analysis (RDANA) to assess the needs and situations of the affected individuals for timely and appropriate interventions.

A total of **852 families** or **2,370 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 123, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex A).

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

There are **852 families** or **2,370 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Moriones Street** in **Brgy. 123, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex B).

A total of **343 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 123**, **Tondo**, **Manila City** (see Annex C).
