

# DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 650, Tondo, Manila City

as of 25 April 2025, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 23 April 2025 at around 12:03 AM, a fire incident occurred at 11th and 12th Sts., Brgy. 650, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 6:59 AM. Due to the incident, 2,651 individuals were affected, significantly damaging their houses.

As part of the response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) National Capital Region (NCR), immediately conducted Rapid Disaster Assessment and Needs Analysis (RDANA) to assess the needs and situations of the affected individuals.

A total of 1,165 families or 2,651 persons are affected in Brgy. 650, Tondo, Manila City (see Annex A).

## a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 1,165 families or 2,651 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Barangay Hall of Brgy. 650, Tondo, Manila City (see Annex B).

A total of **600 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 650**, **Tondo**, **Manila City** (see Annex C).
