

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Dontogan, Baguio City as of 09 May 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 18 April 2025 at around 3:40 AM, a fire incident occurred at Foggy Hill Talco Compound, Brgy. Dontogan, Baguio City. The fire was declared out at around 4:20 AM.

### IV. Damaged Houses

**One (1) house** was totally damaged in **Brgy. Dontogan, Baguio City** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱35,000.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, **₱10,000.00** from **DSWD** and **₱25,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
