I. Situation Overview

On 05 April 2025, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Inayawan, Cebu City. The fire was declared out at around 3:34 PM.

A total of **64 families** or **254 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Inayawan, Cebu City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **64 families** or **254 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Inayawan Gym** in **Cebu City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **36 houses** were damaged; of which, **34** are **totally damaged** and **two (2)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Inayawan, Cebu City** (see Annex C).
