

DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 118, Tondo, Manila City as of 01 May 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 23 April 2025 at around 1:57 AM, a fire incident occurred at Rawis St., Brgy. 118, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared under control at 7:09 AM. Due to the incident, 616 individuals were affected resulting in significant damages to their houses.

At present, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) National Capital Region (NCR), is currently processing the request for relief augmentation to the Local Government Unit (LGU) Manila City.

A total of **154 families** or **616 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 118, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **154 families** or **616 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Barangay 118 Covered Court** in **Brgy. 118, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **58 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 118, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex C).
