

## DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 650, Tondo, Manila City as of 30 April 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 23 April 2025 at around 12:03 AM, a fire incident occurred at 11th and 12th Sts., Brgy. 650, Port Area, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 6:59 AM. Due to the incident, 2,651 individuals were affected, significantly damaging their houses.

As part of the response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) National Capital Region (NCR), immediately conducted Rapid Disaster Assessment and Needs Analysis (RDANA) to assess the needs and situations of the affected individuals.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **1,579 families** or **4,737 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 650, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **1,579 families** or **4,737 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Barangay Hall** of **Brgy. 650, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **600 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 650, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex C).
