

DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Effects of Easterlies in Northern Mindanao as of 16 April 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 21 March 2025 at 4:00 AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms caused by Easterlies may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms affecting Northern Mindanao.

On the same day, continuous rainfall due to Easterlies caused flooding and strong winds in the municipalities of Tubod and Sapa, Lanao del Norte; and Kinoguitan, Misamis Oriental.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) through its Field Office (FO) X, in coordination with the concerned Local Government Units (LGUs), promptly provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **2,986 families** or **7,785 persons** are affected in **21 barangays** in **Northern Mindanao** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **50 families** or **150 persons** sought temporary shelter in **three (3) evacuation centers** in **Lanao del Norte** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **30 families** or **100 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **80 families** or **250 persons** were displaced in **Lanao del Norte** (see Annex D).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱1,544,425.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex E).
