

## DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Flash Flood Incidents in Glan, Sarangani as of 08 April 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

Issued on 31 March 2025 at 4:00 AM, the weather report indicated partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms, attributed to the prevailing Easterlies. These conditions heightened the risk of flash floods or landslides, particularly during severe thunderstorms, across Metro Manila and the rest of the country.

On the same day, several barangays in Glan, Sarangani, experienced flash floods due to heavy rainfall brought by Easterlies.

In response to the incident, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) through its Field Office (FO) XII, in coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Glan, Sarangani, provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **5,810 families** or **29,050 persons** are affected in **12 barangays** in **Glan, Sarangani** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **447 families** or **1,631 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Municipal Gymnasium** in **Glan, Sarangani** (see Annex B).

### IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱1,866,000.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
