

DSWD DROMIC Report #5 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Paknaan, Mandaue City

as of 26 April 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 23 March 2025 at around 7:34 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Paknaan, Mandaue City. The fire was declared out at around 10:32 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **271 families** or **1,007 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Paknaan, Mandaue City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **271 families** or **1,007 persons** sought temporary shelter in **one (1) evacuation center** in **Brgy. Paknaan, Mandaue City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 180 houses were damaged; of which, 173 are totally damaged and seven (7) are partially damaged in Brgy. Paknaan, Mandaue City (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P2,955,041.36** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
