

DSWD DROMIC Report on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. San Jose (Pob.), City of Antipolo, Rizal

11 April 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 16 February 2025, an armed conflict transpired between the 80th Infantry Battalion (80IB), under the 2nd Infantry (Jungle Fighter) Division (2ID) and the New People's Army insurgents in Brgy. San Jose, City of Antipolo, Rizal.

Relative to this incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in the CALABARZON Region, swiftly provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected populace.

A total of **276 families** or **1,318 persons** were affected in **Brgy. San Jose, City of Antipolo, Rizal** (see Annex A).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided
