

# DSWD DROMIC Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Alijis, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental

03 April 2025, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On March 26, 2025, at approximately 6:54 AM, a fire broke out in Purok Spaghab, Brgy. Alijis, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental. The incident resulted in the total destruction of three (3) houses, displacing three families, or a total of 10 individuals. The affected families sought refuge with relatives within the same barangay.

In response to the incident, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office in Region VI and in coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Bacolod City, provided relief assistance to address the immediate needs of the displaced families and individuals.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **three (3) families** or **10 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Alijis, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

### Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **three (3) families** or **10 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **three (3) houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Alijis, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex C).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱32,370.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of **₱19,500.00** from **DSWD** and **₱12,870.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
