

DSWD DROMIC Report on the Flooding Incidents in Dipolog City, Zamboanga del Norte

24 April 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 07 December 2024 at 4:00 PM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms may have brought heavy rainfall and flooding due to the Inter-Tropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting Mindanao.

On the same day, heavy rainfall brought by the ITCZ led to flooding in several barangays in Dipolog City, Zamboanga del Norte.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) through its Field Office (FO) IX, in close coordination with the affected Local Government Units (LGUs) of Zamboanga del Norte promptly provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families.

A total of **658 families** or **3,290 persons** were affected in **three (3) barangays** in **Dipolog City, Zamboanga del Norte** (see Annex A).
