

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Effects of Easterlies in Davao Region

23 June 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 17 March 2025 at 4:00 AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms were observed, attributed to the Easterlies. These conditions likely contributed to the risk of flash floods and landslides, as moderate to at times heavy rains affected the Davao Region. On the same day, continuous rainfall brought by the Easterlies led to flooding and landslides in the municipalities of Mabini, Davao de Oro and Malita, Davao Occidental.

In response to the incident, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) in Region XI, together with the affected Local Government Units (LGUs), promptly provided relief assistance to address the immediate needs of the affected families.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **6,188 families** or **25,806 persons** were affected in **19 barangays** in the **Davao Region** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **eight (8) families** or **29 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Tribal Building, Old Barangay Hall** in **Brgy. Malinawon, Mawab, Davao de Oro** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **190 families** or **529 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **198 families** or **558 persons** were displaced in **Davao Region** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **15 houses** were damaged; of which, **10** were **totally damaged** and **five (5)** were **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Napnapan, Pantukan, Davao de Oro** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱7,409,691.92** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱7,332,311.92** from **DSWD**, and **₱77,380.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
