

# **DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Effects of Shear Line in Catmon, Cebu**

27 April 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

Issued on 29 January 2025 at 4:00 AM, cloudy skies with scattered rains and isolated thunderstorms may have caused possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to heavy rains due to effects of Shear Line.

On the same day, motorbanca operations were suspended in the municipality of Catmon, Cebu due to heavy rains and large waves caused by the effects of Shear Line, which affected the livelihood of the fisherfolk living in coastal barangays.
