

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Cadagmayan Norte, Santa Barbara, Iloilo

15 May 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 22 April 2025 at around 3:30 PM, a fire broke out in Brgy. Cadagmayan Norte, Santa Barbara, Iloilo. The Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) responded to the scene and extinguished the fire by 4:30 PM. The fire destroyed several residential structures, displacing residents who were subsequently accommodated in a nearby evacuation center.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of three (3) families or twenty (20) persons were affected in Brgy. Cadagmayan Norte, Santa Barbara, Iloilo (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

Three (3) families or twenty (20) persons sought temporary shelter at the Cadagmayan Norte Covered Court in Brgy. Cadagmayan Norte, Santa Barbara, Iloilo (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of three (3) houses were damaged; of which, two (2) are totally damaged and one (1) is partially damaged in Brgy. Cadagmayan Norte, Santa Barbara, Iloilo (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱21,066.00 worth of assistance was provided by the **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
