

# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion III, Hamtic, Antique

22 June 2025, 6AM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 20 April 2025 at around 5:18 PM, a fire broke out in Brgy. Poblacion III, Hamtic, Antique. The fire destroyed several residential structures and displaced numerous families. These families were temporarily accommodated at the Barangay Hall of Brgy. Poblacion III in Hamtic, Antique.

In response, the DSWD, through its Field Office in Region VI, provided immediate relief assistance to support the needs of the affected families.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of six (6) families or 16 persons were affected in Brgy. Poblacion III, Hamtic, Antique (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

A total of **six (6) families** or **16 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Barangay Hall** in **Brgy. Poblacion III, Hamtic, Antique** (see Annex B). These families eventually returned home after building makeshift houses.

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of six (6) houses were damaged; of which, five (5) are totally damaged and one (1) are partially damaged in Brgy. Poblacion III, Hamtic, Antique (see Annex D).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P67,716.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families; of which, **P37,716.00** from **DSWD** and **P30,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex E).
