

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in the City of Guihulngan, Negros Oriental as of 03 May 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 01 May 2025, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. Humayhumay, City of Guihulngan, Negros Oriental between the 62nd Infantry Battalion of the Philippine Army and members of the Communist Party of the Philippines - New People's Army (CPP-NPA). Due to the incident, several residents in the area were affected and forced to take temporary shelter in the evacuation centers (ECs).

At present, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) VII, is closely coordinating with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of City of Guihulngan, Negros Oriental, for any relief augmentation support.

A total of **69 families** or **259 persons** are affected in **four (4) barangays** in the **City of Guihulngan, Negros Oriental** (see Annex A).

There are **69 families** or **259 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **four (4) ECs** in the **City of Guihulngan, Negros Oriental** (see Annex B).
