

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Civil Unrest in Basilan as of 28 May 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 11 - 12 May 2025, several shooting incidents were monitored by the Basilan Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction Management Council through its Response Clusters in the Province of Basilan. Said incidents resulted in multiple casualties and the displacement of 4,612 individuals.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) IX, is in close coordination with the Provincial Local Government Unit (PLGU) of Basilan to cater to the said province's augmentation request.

A total of **1,011 families** or **4,625 persons** are affected in **Basilan** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Outside Evacuation Center

There are **1,000 families** or **4,612 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).
