

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Civil Unrest in Pandag, Maguindanao del Sur as of 14 May 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 10 May 2025 at around 12AM, a shooting incident transpired between an alleged private army group and political supporters in Brgy. Pandag and Lower D'Iag, Pandag, Maguindanao del Sur. The incident resulted in multiple casualties and displacement of families.
