

# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Clustering of Suspected Diarrhoeal Cases in Cordillera Administrative Region

as of 29 May 2025, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 29 April 2025, several suspected diarrhea cases were reported in Brgy. Sacpil, Conner, Apayao. The investigation of the Municipal Health Office of Conner confirmed the presence of E.coli and total coliform bacteria in several community water sources in the Barangay. From 29 April to 06 May 2025, 84 cases were recorded.

Additional cases emerged between 14 to 19 May 2025 which prompted an emergency meeting between the Provincial Health Office, Rural Health Unit (RHU)-Conner, Conner District Hospital (CDH) and the Department of Health-Cordillera Administrative Region (DOH-CAR). On May 26, 2025, the CAR - Regional Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (RDRRMC) raised the Blue Alert Status due to new cases being reported.

A total of 279 individuals were affected by diarrhea cases from the provinces of Apayao and Kalinga. Of the cases, a total of 200 were mostly from Brgy. Sacpil, Conner Apayao, and 79 were from the Municipalities of Balbalan, Pinukpuk, and City of Tabuk, Kalinga.

Diarrhoeal disease or Diarrhea is defined as the passage of three or more loose or liquid stools per day (or more frequent passage than is normal for the individual). Frequent passing of formed stools is not diarrhea, nor is the passing of loose, "pasty" stools by breastfed babies. Diarrhea is usually a symptom of an infection in the intestinal tract, which can be caused by a variety of bacterial, viral, and parasitic organisms. Infection is spread through contaminated food or drinking-water, or from person-to-person due to poor hygiene.
