

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Effects of Easterlies in Davao Region as of 13 May 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 13 May 2025 at 4:00 AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms were observed, attributed to the Easterlies. These conditions may have led to possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms affecting the Davao Region.

Localized flooding incidents were reported particularly in Panabo City, Davao del Norte, and Maragusan, Davao de Oro. The latter being due to the downstream overflow of Tagbibinta Falls. No casualties have been reported but minor property damages have been recorded.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **452 families** or **1,993 persons** are affected in **five (5) barangays** in the **Davao Region** (see Annex A).

III. Damaged Houses

A total of **165 houses** were damaged; of which, **15** are **totally damaged** and **150** are **partially damaged** in the **Maragusan, Davao de Oro** (see Annex B).
