

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Effects of Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) in Davao Region

as of 01 May 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 26 April 2025 at 4:00 AM, the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) is affecting Mindanao. Cloudy skies with scattered rains and thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains.

On the same day, several barangays in Mawab, Davao de Oro, and Jose Abad Santos, Davao Occidental experienced flooding and landslides due to continuous heavy rainfall brought about by the prevailing ITCZ.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **186 families** or **760 persons** are affected in **Davao Region** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **75 families** or **259 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 14 houses were damaged; of which, four (4) are totally damaged and 10 are partially damaged in Davao Region (see Annex C).
