

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Effects of Localized Thunderstorm in Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat as of 30 May 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued at 4:00 PM on 29 May 2025, the weather advisory indicated partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rain showers or thunderstorms, which may have caused flash floods or landslides during severe weather conditions across the country.

On the same day, heavy rainfall affected several barangays in Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat, resulting in damage to multiple properties.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office in Region XII, actively participated in the response operations and remained in continuous coordination with the concerned Local Government Unit (LGU) for significant updates and potential requests for relief augmentation.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **991 families** or **4,995 persons** are affected in **10 barangays** in **Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat** (see Annex A).

III. Damaged Houses

A total of **55 houses** were damaged; of which, **one (1)** is **totally damaged** and **54** are **partially damaged** in **Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat** (see Annex B).
