

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 106, Tondo, Manila City as of 19 May 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 18 May 2025 at around 2:35 PM, a fire broke out at 136 Cardena De Amor St., Brgy. 106, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 4:20 PM. Several residential houses were completely destroyed, displacing numerous families who were accommodated in an evacuation center in the area. No casualties were reported.

A total of **75 families** or **225 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 106, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex A).

There are **75 families** or **225 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Barangay Hall** in **Brgy. 106, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex B).

A total of **26 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 106, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex C).
