

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 595 and 596, Sta. Mesa, Manila City as of 08 May 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 02 May 2025 at around 9:10 PM, a fire incident occurred at Ang Buhay St., cor. V. Mapa, Brgy. 595 and 596, Sta. Mesa, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 10:09 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **50 families** or **200 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 595 and 596, Sta. Mesa, Manila City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **50 families** or **200 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **15 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 595 and 596, Sta. Mesa, Manila City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱96,450.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
