

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 628, Sta. Mesa, Manila City

as of 20 May 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 19 May 2025 at around 3:42 PM, a fire broke out at Road 12, NDC Compound, Brgy. 628, Sta. Mesa, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 3:06 AM the following day. Several houses were completely destroyed, and many residents were displaced.

A total of 215 families or 759 persons are affected in Brgy. 628, Sta. Mesa, Manila City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 215 families or 759 persons currently taking temporary shelter in three (3) evacuation centers in Brgy. 628, Sta. Mesa, Manila City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **60 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 628**, **Sta. Mesa**, **Manila City** (see Annex C).

- 780,234 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 406,673 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 373,561 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 54,879 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱79.1 million worth of other FNIs available at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.
