

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 767, San Andres Bukid, Manila City as of 01 May 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 28 April 2025 at around 3:13 AM, a fire incident occurred at Estrada St., and Onyx St., in Brgy. 767, San Andres Bukid, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 7:02 AM.

A total of **173 families** or **593 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 767, San Andres Bukid, Manila City** (see Annex A).

There are **173 families** or **593 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in the tents established along **Onyx Street** in **Brgy. 767, San Andres Bukid, Manila City** (see Annex B).

A total of **20 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 767, San Andres Bukid, Manila City** (see Annex C).
