

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Butac, Aguinaldo, Ifugao

as of 30 May 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 May 2025 at around 11:00 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Butac, Aguinaldo, Ifugao. The fire was declared out the next day at around 3:35 AM. No casualties or injured individuals were reported.

One (1) family or three (3) persons are affected in Brgy. Butac, Aguinaldo, Ifugao (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **three (3) persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Buguias, Benguet (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱24,943.18** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected family (see Annex D).
