

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Camaman-an, Cagayan de Oro City as of 23 May 2025, AM

I. Situation Overview

On 16 May 2025 at around 9:00 AM, a fire incident occurred at Daclag Compound in Sitio Bontong, Brgy. Camaman-an, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental. The Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) promptly responded to the scene and extinguished the fire by 11:24 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **20 families** or **65 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Camaman-an, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **10 families** or **36 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Hall** in **Brgy. Camaman-an, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **11 houses** were damaged; of which, **10** are **totally damaged** and **one (1)** is **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Camaman-an, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱209,480.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱167,480.00** from **DSWD** and **₱42,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
