

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Camaman-an, Cagayan de Oro City

as of 23 May 2025, AM

I. Situation Overview

On 16 May 2025 at around 9:00 AM, a fire incident occurred at Daclag Compound in Sitio Bontong, Brgy. Camaman-an, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental. The Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) promptly responded to the scene and extinguished the fire by 11:24 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **20 families** or **65 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Camaman-an, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **10 families** or **36 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy**. **Hall** in **Brgy**. **Camaman-an**, **Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **11** houses were damaged; of which, **10** are totally damaged and one (1) is partially damaged in Brgy. Camaman-an, Cagayan de Oro City (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱209,480.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱167,480.00 from DSWD and ₱42,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).
