

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. East Modern Site, Baguio City as of 30 May 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 13 May 2025 at around 12:35 PM, a fire broke out at Purok 5, Navarro Alley, Ledesma St. in Brgy. East Modern Site, Baguio City. The fire was declared out at around 1:10 PM. It destroyed residential structures, displacing several families who have since sought temporary shelter with relatives.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **four (4) families** or **16 persons** are affected in **Brgy. East Modern Site, Baguio City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **four (4) families** or **16 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **two (2) houses** were damaged; of which, **one (1)** is **totally damaged** and **one (1)** is **partially damaged** in **Brgy. East Modern Site, Baguio City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱67,676.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱22,576.00** from **DSWD** and **₱45,100.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
