

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Labangal, General Santos City as of 06 May 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 05 May 2025 at around 11:55 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Labangal, General Santos City. The fire destroyed several residential structures, displacing numerous families and individuals in the area.

A total of **112 families** or **497 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Labangal, General Santos City** (see Annex A).

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **112 families** or **497 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at **Barangay Labangal Gym** in **General Santos City** (see Annex B).
