

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Mandalagan, Bacolod City as of 30 May 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 25 May 2025 at around 3:32 AM, a residential fire occurred in Barangay. Mandalagan, Bacolod City. The incident resulted in the total destruction of one house and the tragic death of a child. The cause of the fire remains under investigation by the Bureau of Fire Protection.

The fire displaced one (1) family consisting of five (5) individuals. The affected family, who are beneficiaries of the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps), is currently staying with relatives.

In response to the incident, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office in Region VI, in coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Bacolod City, extended relief assistance and financial aid to address the immediate needs of the affected family.

Meanwhile, the Bacolod City Government, through the City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO), is currently facilitating the provision of additional financial assistance to support the bereaved family during this difficult time.

**One (1) house** was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Mandalagan, Bacolod City** (see Annex C).

A total of **₱31,730.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
