I. Situation Overview

On 05 May 2025 at around 11:35 AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok Tadena, Brgy. Mankilam, City of Tagum, Davao del Norte. The fire was declared out at around 12:26 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 200 families or 500 persons are affected in Brgy. Mankilam, City of Tagum, Davao del Norte (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 105 families or 385 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Brgy. Mankilam Gymnasium in the City of Tagum, Davao del Norte (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 40 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Mankilam, City of Tagum, Davao del Norte (see Annex C).
