

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Nazareth, Cagayan de Oro City

as of 03 May 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 30 April 2025 at around 9:00 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Nazareth, Cagayan de Oro City. The fire was declared out at around 11:00 AM. Due to the incident, 76 individuals were affected resulting in significant damages to their houses.

At present, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) X, is closely coordinating with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Cagayan de Oro City, for any relief augmentation support.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **18 families** or **76 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Nazareth, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are six (6) families or 18 persons currently taking temporary shelter at Brgy. Nazareth Health Center in Cagayan de Oro City (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **four (4) families** or **12 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **10 families** or **30 persons** still displaced in **Brgy. Nazareth, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **15** houses were damaged; of which, nine (9) are totally damaged and six (6) are partially damaged in Brgy. Nazareth, Cagayan de Oro City (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱37,800.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **LGU** to the affected families (see Annex F).
